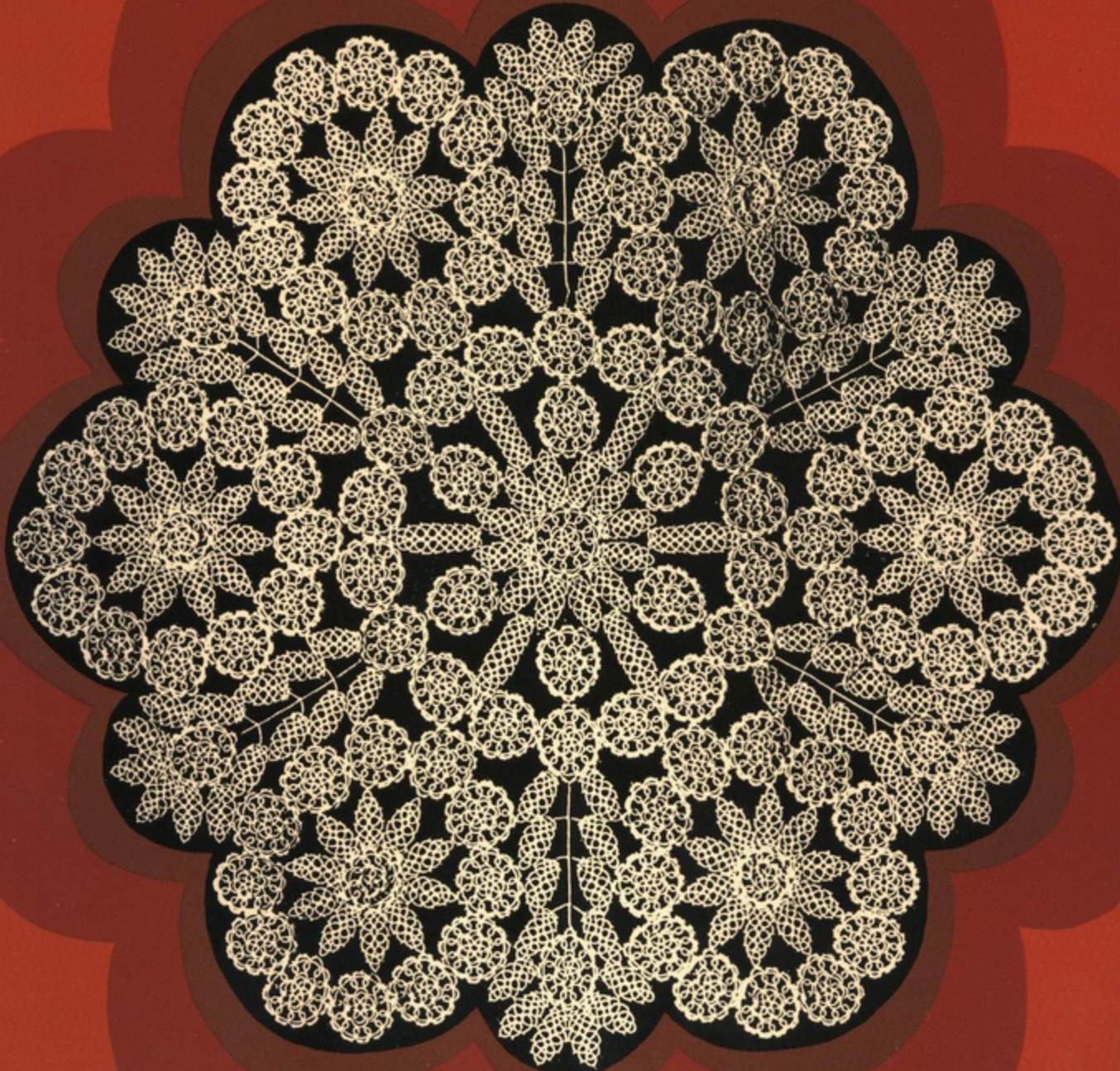


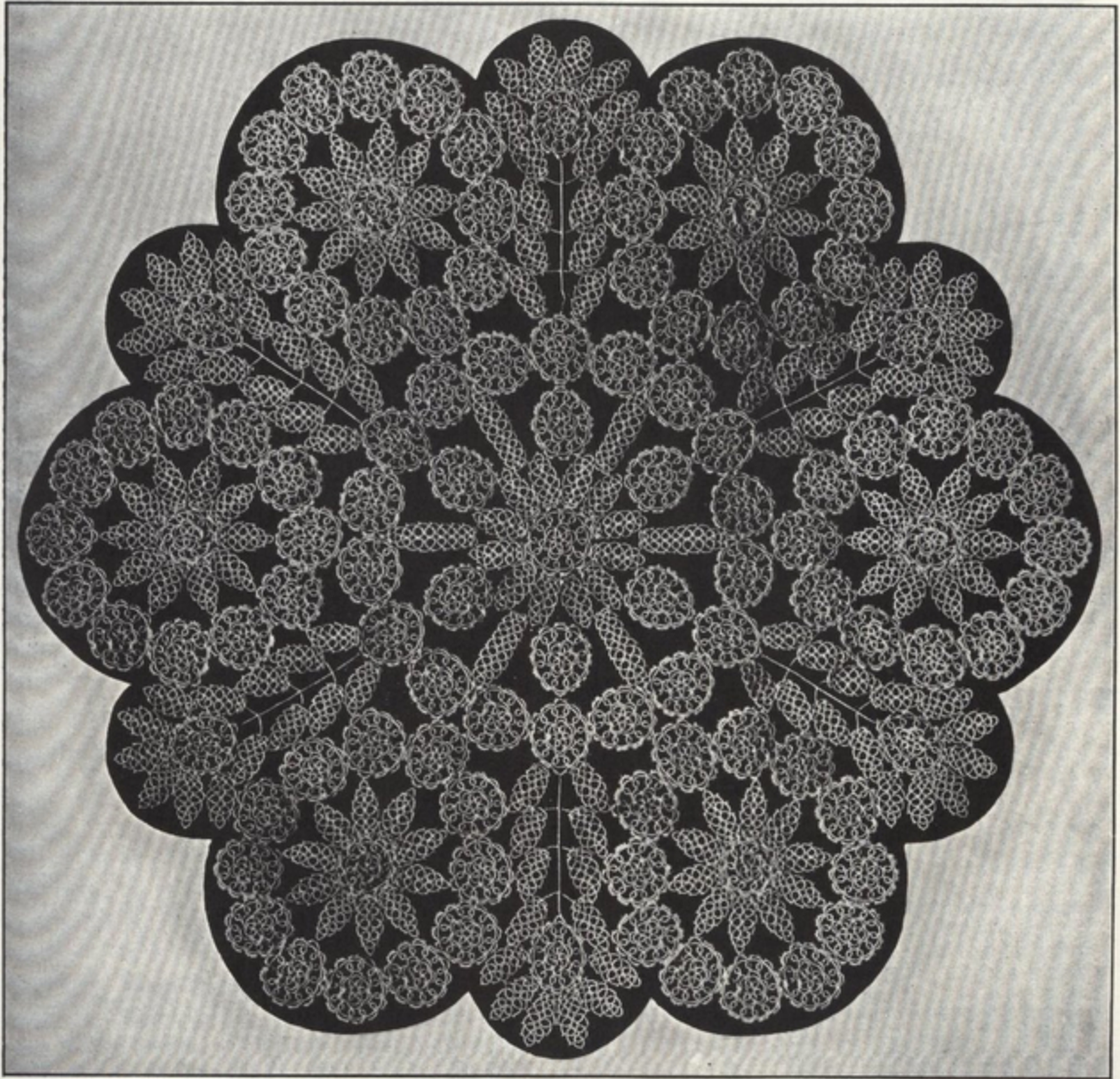

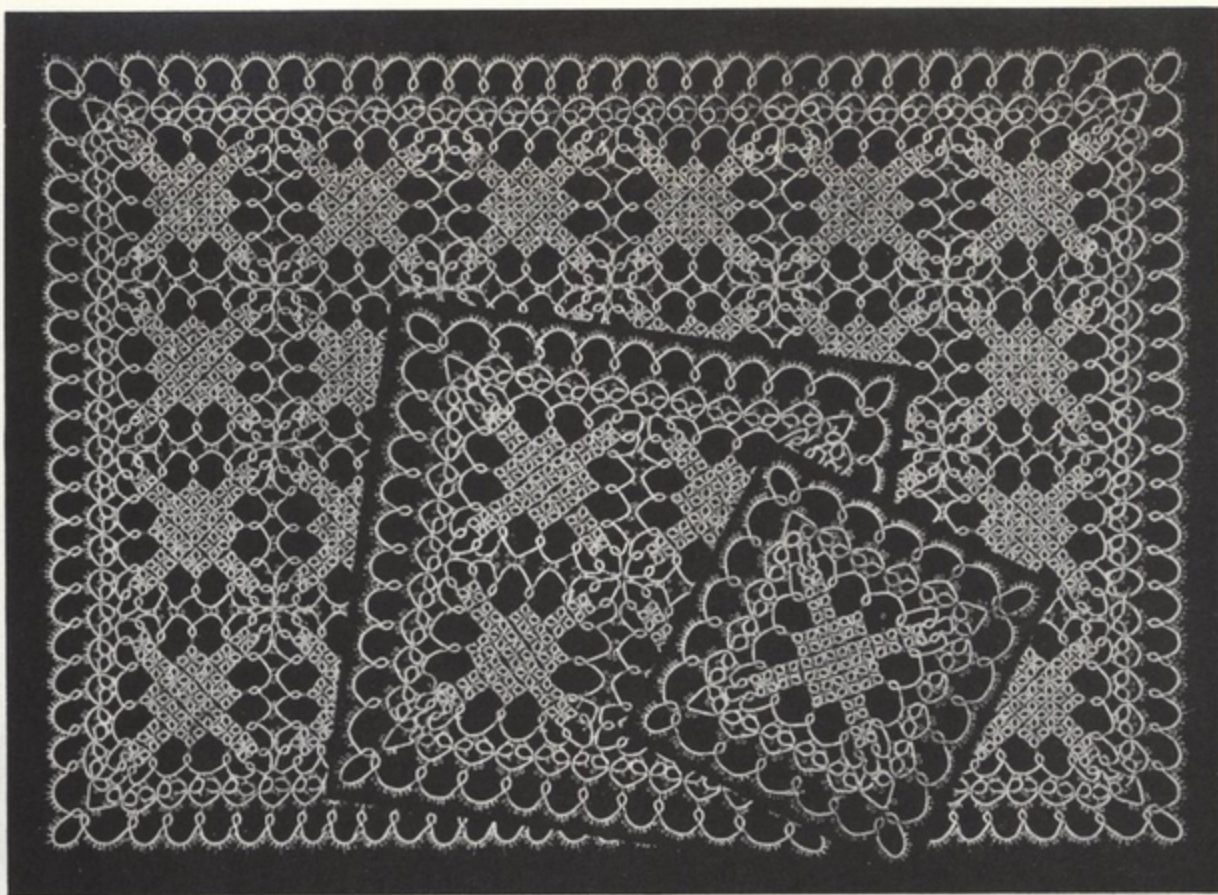


## Centerpiece

## Rectangular Doily Set

(Use No. 40 Crochet Cotton and 2 Shuttles)

### LARGE DOILY

**Small Square Motif:** R 3 ds, 3 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, cl, (r 3 ds, j in 3rd p of last r, 3 ds, 2 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, cl) twice, r 3 ds, j in 3rd p of last r, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, j in first p of first r, 3 ds, cl. Tie and cut.

Make 16 more small motifs and j together by center p of each motif as in illustration. Then, r 6 ds, j in right corner p of corner motif, 6 ds, cl, \* ch 6 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 6 ds, r 6 ds, j in next corner p of same motif, 6 ds, cl, ch 6 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 6 ds, r 6 ds, j in p between 2 motifs, 6 ds, cl, ch 6 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 6 ds, r 6 ds, j in p of next motif, 6 ds, cl, ch 6 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 6 ds, r 6 ds, j in p between 2 motifs, 6 ds, cl, ch 6 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 6 ds, r 6 ds, j in corner p of next motif, 6 ds, cl. Repeat from \* around. Tie and cut.

Make 23 more motifs as above. Join each together as shown by center p of each ch.

**1st row around:** R 5 ds, j in first p of corner ch, 5 ds, 2 p sep by 5 ds, 5 ds, cl, ch 9 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 9 ds, \* r 5 ds,

p, 5 ds, j in center p of last r, 5 ds, sk 1 p of ch, j in next p, 5 ds, cl, r 5 ds, j in first p of next ch, 5 ds, 2 p sep by 5 ds, 5 ds, cl, ch 6 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 6 ds. Repeat from \* around, making each corner as first was made.

**2nd row:** R 7 ds, j in center p of corner ch, 7 ds, cl, ch 5 ds, 12 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, r 7 ds, j in same p with last r, 7 ds, cl, \* ch 5 ds, 9 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, r 7 ds, j in center p of next ch, 7 ds, cl. Repeat from \* around, making each corner as first was made.

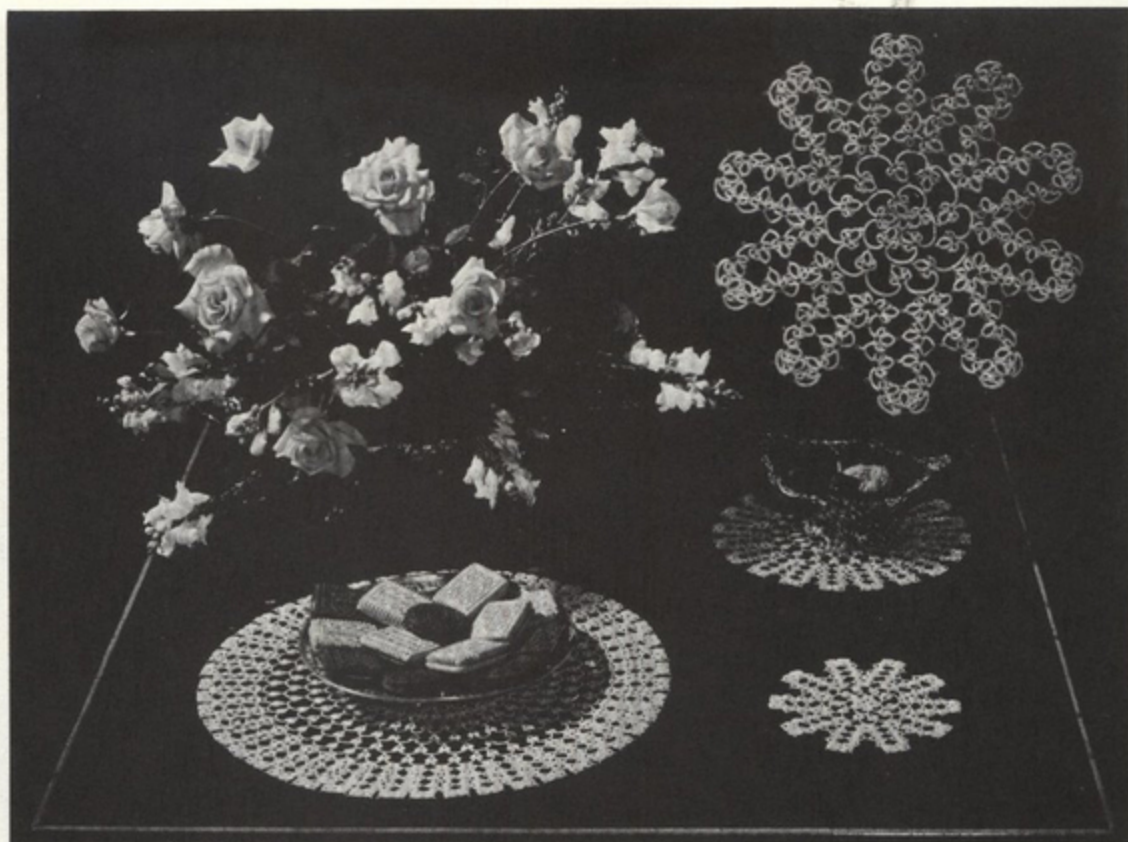
### MEDIUM SIZE DOILY

Make 4 large motifs and j as for large doily. Then make 1st and 2nd rows like large doily.

### SMALL DOILY

Make one large motif as for large doily. Then make 1st and 2nd rows around.





## A Flower-Like Set

(Use No. 30 Crochet Cotton and 2 Shuttles)

### LARGE DOILY

**Center Ring:** R 5 p sep by 2 ds, cl. Tie and cut.

**1st row:** \* (Sr 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl) (lr 4 ds, j to p of last r, 4 ds, j to p of center r, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl, sr 4 ds, j to last p of lr, 4 ds, cl. Ch (7 ds, p) twice, 7 ds. Repeat from \* around center r. Tie and cut.

**2nd row:** Repeat first row. J each lr to a p of first row.

**3rd row:** Repeat 2nd row.

**4th row:** \* (Sr 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl, lr 4 ds, j to p of sr, 4 ds, j to p of last row, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl, sr 4 ds, j to p of lr, 4 ds, cl, ch 7 ds, p, 7 ds. Repeat from \* around. Tie and cut.

**5th and 6th rows:** Repeat 4th row.

**7th row:** \* (Sr 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl, lr 4 ds, j to p of sr, 4 ds, j to p of last row, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl, sr 4 ds, j to p of lr, 4 ds, cl, ch 7 ds, p, 7 ds) 4 times, sr 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl, lr 4 ds, j to p of sr, 4 ds, j to p of last row, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl, sr 4 ds, j to p of lr, 4 ds, cl, ch (7 ds, p) twice, 7 ds. Repeat from \* around. Tie and cut.

**8th row:** Repeat 2nd row.

**9th row: Edge:** Sr 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl, lr 4 ds, j to p of sr, (4 ds, p) twice, 4 ds, cl, \* sr 4 ds, j to p of lr, j to first p of a ch of last row, 4 ds, cl, sr 4 ds, j to next p of same ch of last row, p, 4 ds, cl, lr 4 ds, j to p of sr, (4 ds, p) twice, 4 ds, cl, sr 4 ds, j to p of lr, p, 4 ds, cl, (ch 4 ds, p, 4 ds, sr 4 ds, j to p of sr, p, 4 ds, cl, lr 4 ds, j to p of sr, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl, sr 4 ds, j to p of lr, p, 4 ds, cl) 3 times, (ch 4 ds, p, 4 ds, sr 4 ds, j to p of sr, p, 4 ds, cl, lr 4 ds, j to p of sr, 4 ds, j to center p of last lr, 4 ds, p 4 ds, cl, sr 4 ds, j to p of lr, p, 4 ds, cl) twice, (ch 4 ds, p, 4 ds, sr 4 ds, j to p of sr, p, 4 ds, cl, lr 4 ds, j to p of sr, 4 ds, j to center p of opposite lr, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl, sr 4 ds, j to p of lr, p, 4 ds, cl) twice, ch 4 ds, p, 4 ds, sr 4 ds, j to p of sr, 4 ds, cl, lr 4 ds, j to p of sr, 4 ds, j to p of opposite lr, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. ### MEDIUM DOILY

Make center ring, 1st, 2nd, 4th, 8th and 9th rows of large doily.

### SMALL DOILY

Make center ring, 1st, 2nd and 9th rows.



## Large Round Doily

(Use No. 60 Crochet Cotton and 2 Shuttles)

R 2 ds, 5 p with 3 ds between, cl, tie and cut.

**1st row:** R 2 ds, p, 2 ds, j to a p of center r, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, cl, \* ch 2 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, r 2 ds, p, 2 ds, j to next p of center r, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, cl, repeat from \* around. Tie and cut.

**2nd row:** R 2 ds, p, 2 ds, j to second p of ch (counting from left), 2 ds, p, 2 ds, cl, \* ch 10 ds, r 2 ds, p, 2 ds, sk 1 p on ch, j to next p, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, cl, repeat from \* around, j r to second and fourth p on p ch of last row, j to first r.

**3rd row:** Ch 2 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, j between preceding row. Repeat around. Tie and cut.

**4th row:** R 2 ds, p, 2 ds, j in second p of ch, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, cl, \* ch 2 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, r 2 ds, p, 2 ds,

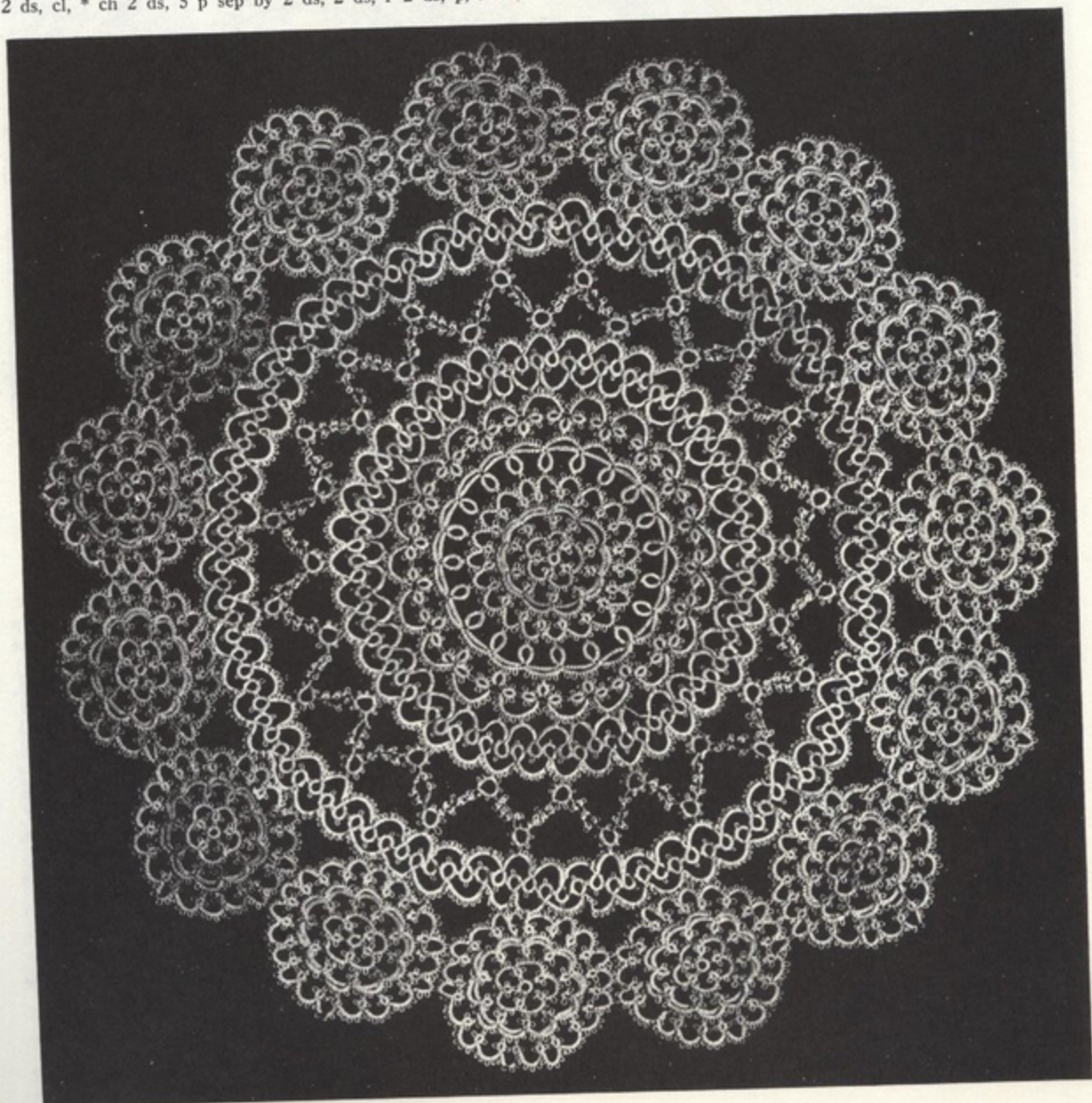
j to fourth p of same ch, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, cl, repeat from \*, j r to second and fourth p on p ch of last row, tie and cut.

**5th row:** \* R 10 ds, j to center p on ch, 10 ds, cl, ch 10 ds, repeat from \* around.

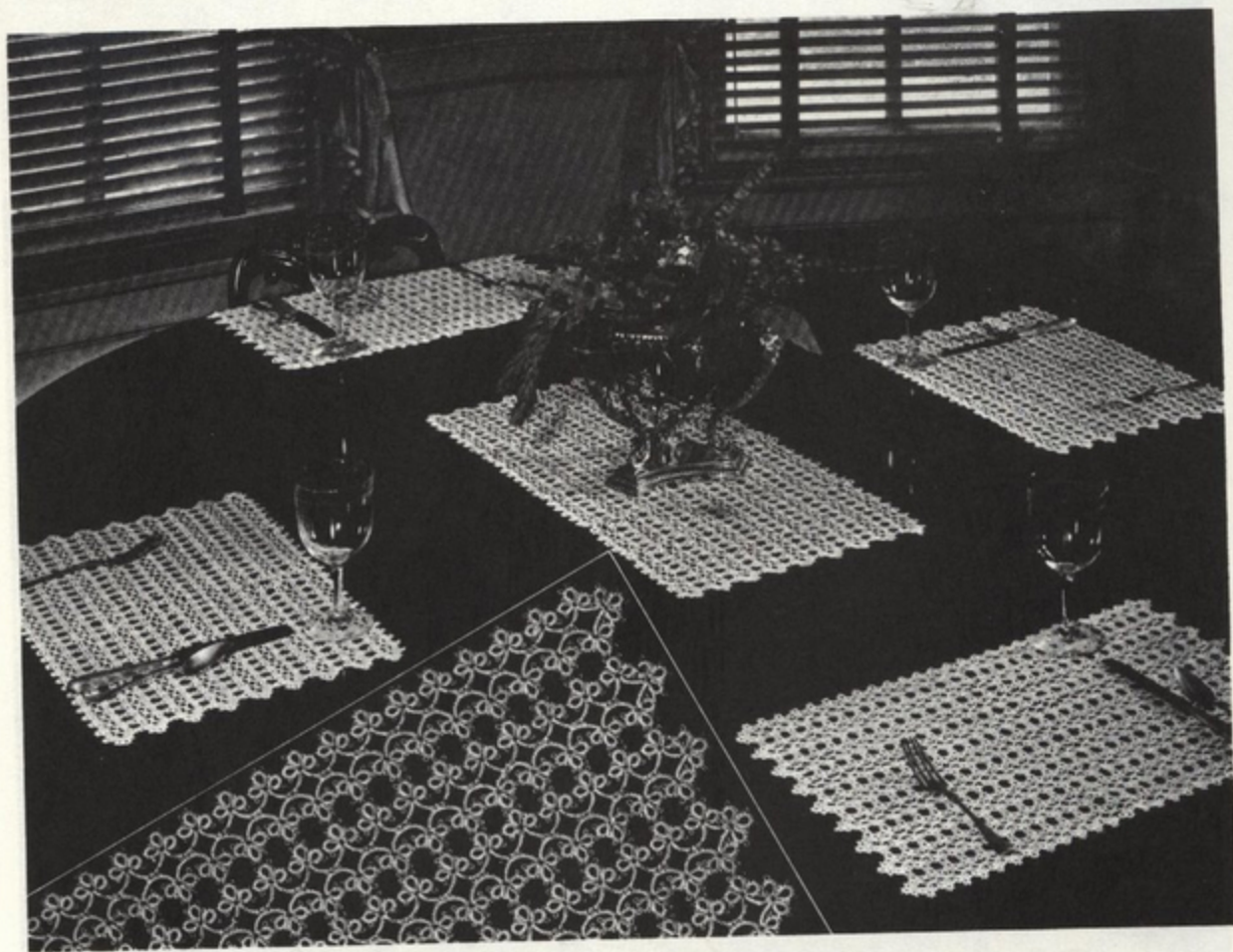
**6th row:** \* Ch 2 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, j between ch of preceding row. Tie and cut.

**7th row:** R 2 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl, r 2 ds, j to fifth p of last r, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, j to center p of ch (last row), 2 ds, p, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, cl, \* r 2 ds, j to fifth p of last r, 2 ds, 4 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl, ch 2 ds, 10 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, r 2 ds, p, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, j to third p of last r, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, cl, r 2 ds, j to fifth p of last r, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, j to center p of next ch, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, cl, repeat from \* around. Tie and cut.

## A Simple Set

(Use No. 10 Crochet Cotton and 2 Shuttles)

R 4 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 4 ds, cl; r 4 ds, j to last p of 1st r, 2 ds, 4 p sep by 2 ds, 4 ds, cl; r 4 ds, j to last p of 2nd r, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. Ch 8 ds, turn, r 4 ds, p, 3 ds, j to last p of last r of first cluster, 3 ds, p, 4 ds, cl.

\* R 4 ds, j to last p of last r, 2 ds, 4 p sep by 2 ds, 4 ds, cl, r 4 ds, j to last p of 2nd r, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. Turn, ch 7 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 7 ds, turn, r 4 ds, p, 3 ds, j to center p of last r, 3 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. Repeat from \* until desired length is reached, about 18 inches for place mat and 26 inches for runner.

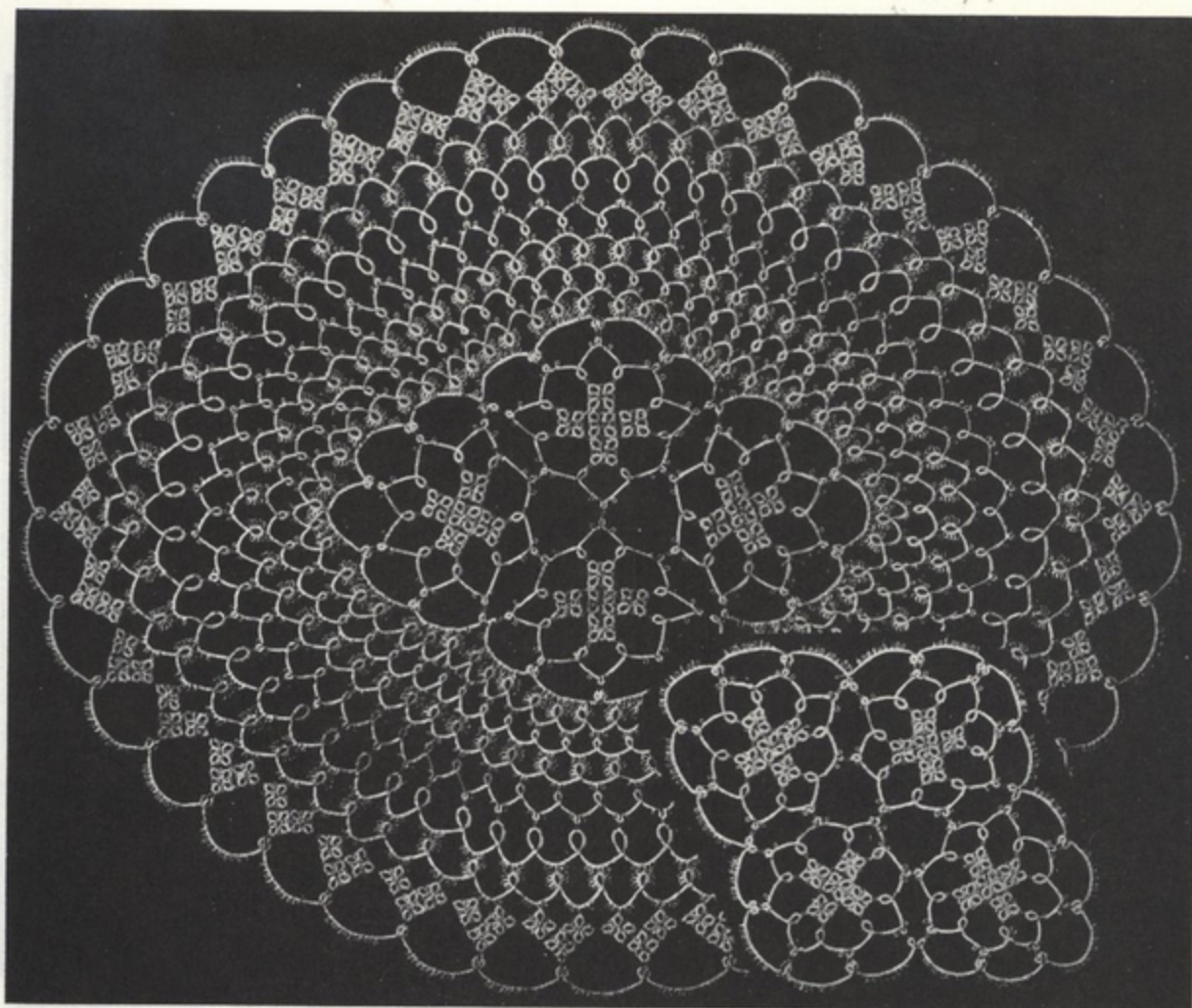
Ch 8 ds, r 4 ds, j to 2nd p of last r in last cluster, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 4 ds, cl, r 4 ds, j to last p in first r, 2 ds, 4 p sep by 2 ds, 4 ds, cl.

R 4 ds, j to last p of 2nd r, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 4 ds, cl, turn. Ch 8 ds, turn, r 4 ds, p, 3 ds, j to last p of 3rd r of last cluster. \* Finish cluster with 2 r, turn, ch 7 ds, j to last p in ch as shown, 2 ds, j to 2nd p, 2 ds, j to 3rd p, 7 ds, turn, r 4 ds, p, 3 ds, j to 2nd p of last r in last cluster. Repeat from \*.

To finish off j 2nd p of 3rd r of last cluster to 1st p of 1st cluster, turn, ch 8 ds, fasten off.

For a place mat, make 9 finished strips, j by the center p of last r as the work proceeds. For the runner make 9 strips of 36 clusters each.





## A Lacy Set

(Use No. 30 Crochet Cotton and 2 Shuttles)

### LARGE DOILY

**For Motifs:** R 3 ds, 3 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, cl, (r 3 ds, j in last p of last r, 3 ds, 2 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, cl) twice, r 3 ds, j in last p of last r, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, j in p of first r, 3 ds, cl. Tie and cut. Make 4 more small motifs, j at corners as in illustration.

Then, r 6 ds, j in center p of r of last row, 6 ds, cl, \* ch 9 ds, p, 3 ds, r 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl, ch 3 ds, p, 9 ds, r 6 ds, j in center p of next r of last row, 6 ds, cl. Repeat from \* around. Tie and cut.

Make 3 more motifs as one just made. Join together by p of small r of last row as in illustration to form a diamond.

**1st row around:** R 3 ds, j in p of first small r to left on side where 2 motifs were j, 3 ds, cl, \* r 3 ds, j in p of first sr of next motif, 3 ds, cl, (ch 4 ds, 9 p sep by 2 ds, 4 ds, r 3 ds, j in p of next sr of same motif, 3 ds, cl, r 3 ds, j in same p with last r, 3 ds, cl) 3 times, ch 4 ds, 9 p sep by 2 ds, 4 ds, r 3 ds, j in p of next sr, 3 ds, cl, r 3 ds, j in p of sr of next motif, 3 ds, cl, (ch 4 ds, 9 p sep by 2 ds, 4 ds, r 3 ds, j in p of next sr, 3 ds, cl, r 3 ds, j in same p with last r, 3 ds, cl) twice, ch 6 ds, 12 p sep by 2 ds,

6 ds, (r 3 ds, j in p of next sr, 3 ds, cl, r 3 ds, j in same p with last r, 3 ds, cl, ch 4 ds, 9 p sep by 2 ds, 4 ds) twice, r 3 ds, j in p of next sr, 3 ds, cl. Repeat from \* around. Tie and cut.

**2nd row:** R 2 ds, 4 p, j in 2nd p to right of end ch of 12 p of last row, 4 p, 2 ds, cl, (ch 6 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 6 ds, r 2 ds, 4 p, sk 2 p, j in next p, 4 p, 2 ds, cl) 3 times, \* ch 6 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 6 ds, r 2 ds, 4 p, sk 1 p of next ch, j in next p, 4 p, 2 ds, cl, (ch 6 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 6 ds, r 2 ds, 4 p, sk 2 p of same ch, j in next p, 4 p, 2 ds, cl) twice. Repeat from \* around, tie and cut.

**3rd row:** \* R 5 ds, j in center p of ch of last row, 5 ds, cl, ch 6 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 6 ds, repeat around from \*, tie and cut.

**4th row:** \* R 2 ds, 4 p, j in center p of ch of last row, 4 p, 2 ds, cl, ch 7 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 7 ds. Repeat from \* around, making 3 chs at each end as follows: Ch 8 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 8 ds, tie and cut.

**5th row:** \* R 5 ds, j in center p of ch of last row, 5 ds,

## Rectangular Luncheon Set

### LARGE DOILY

(Use No. 30 Crochet Cotton, and 2 Shuttles)

**Center Small Motifs:** (R 6 ds, 3 p sep by 4 ds, 6 ds, cl) 4 times. Tie and cut.

Make two rows of the motifs with five motifs each. Join together by side p, leaving center p of r free.

**1st row:** \*R 6 ds, p, 5 ds, j to center p of r of corner motif, 5 ds, p, 6 ds, cl, turn, ch 5 ds, 7 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, turn, r 6 ds, p, 5 ds, j to same p with last r, 5 ds, p, 6 ds, cl (turn, ch 5 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, turn, r 6 ds, j to center p of next r, 5 ds, j to center p of next r, 6 ds, cl) 4 times, turn, ch 5 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, turn, r 6 ds, p, 5 ds, j to center p of next r, 5 ds, p, 6 ds, cl, turn, ch 5 ds, 7 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, turn, r 6 ds, p, 5 ds, j to same p with last r, 5 ds, p, 6 ds, cl, turn, ch 5 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, turn, r 6 ds, j to center p of next r, 5 ds, j to center p of next r, 6 ds, cl, turn, ch 5 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, turn. Tie and cut.

**3d row:** R 6 ds, j to second p of center r of small motif, 6 ds, cl, turn, ch 6 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 6 ds, turn, r 6 ds, j to fourth p of same r, 6 ds, cl, turn, ch 6 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 6 ds, turn, r 6 ds, j to second p of next r, 6 ds, cl, \*

(On Page 32)

(Use No. 50 Crochet Cotton and 2 Shuttles)

**Round Motif: 1st Row:** R 7 ds, L p, 7 ds, cl, (ch 10 ds, r 7 ds, j to L p, 7 ds, cl) 5 times, ch 10 ds. Tie and cut (6 rings).

**2nd row:** J cotton between 2 ch of last row, \* (ch 5 ds, p) twice, 5 ds, j between next 2 ch of last row. Repeat from \* around. Tie and cut.

**3rd row:** R 7 ds, j to p of last row, 7 ds, cl, \* ch 10 ds, r 7 ds, j to next p of last row, 7 ds, cl. Repeat from \* around. Tie and cut.

**4th row:** J cotton between 2 ch of last row, \* ch 3 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 3 ds, j between next 2 ch of last row. Repeat from \* around. Tie and cut.

**Leaf Motif:** R 3 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 3 ds, cl, ch 7 ds, p, 2 ds, r 6 ds, j to last p of last r, 2 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 6 ds, cl, ch 7 ds, p, 2 ds, r 8 ds, j to last p of last r, 2 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 8 ds, cl, ch 7 ds, p, 2 ds, r 6 ds, j to last p of last r, 2 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 6 ds, cl, ch 7 ds, j, 2 ds, p, 7 ds, p, 7 ds, r 6 ds, sk 1 p of last ch, j in next p, 4 ds, j in last p of last r, 3 ds, p, 4 ds, cl, ch 2 ds, p, 7 ds, r 6 ds, j in p of last r, 1 ds, j in next p of opposite r, 2 ds, j in next p of same r, 2 ds, p, 6 ds, cl, ch 2 ds, p, 7 ds, r 8 ds, j to p of last r, 2 ds, j to p of opposite r, 2 ds, j to next p of same r, 2 ds, p, 8 ds, cl, ch 2 ds, p, 7 ds, r 6 ds, j to p of last r, 2 ds, j to next p of opposite r, 2 ds, j to next p of same r, 2 ds, p, 6 ds, cl, ch 2 ds, p, 7 ds, r 3 ds, j to p of last r, 2 ds, j to p of opposite r, 2 ds, j to next p of same r, 3 ds, cl, ch 2 ds, p, 7 ds, j in center p of ch of round motif, j in p with last r, 7 ds, p, 2 ds, j to first r. with 8 ds, on each side of leaf. Join motifs together as shown in illustration.

The center motif for tumbler doily has 5 rings in center instead of 6 rings as for other round motifs. Join all motifs as in illustration, then make stems.

**STEMS:** Join cotton to center p of center ch of round motif with 8 leaves around. Ch 10 ds, p, 20 ds, p, 15 ds, p, 12 ds, j to center p of ch of opposite round motif. Tie and cut.

Join cotton to center of base of 2nd leaf, ch 5 ds, j to last p of long stem, 5 ds, j to center at base of opposite leaf. Tie and cut.

Join cotton to center of base of 3rd leaf, ch 6 ds, j to next p of long stem, 6 ds, j to center of base of opposite leaf. Tie and cut.

Join cotton to center of base of 4th leaf, ch 7 ds, j to next p of long stem, 7 ds, j to center of base of opposite leaf. Tie and cut.

## TUMBLER DOILY

Has center made with 5 rings and 10 leaves around. Around this, place 12 round motifs.

## PLATE DOILY

Center has 6 rings with 12 leaves around. Around this, put 6 round motifs alternated with 6 long leaves. Then on outside make 18 round motifs.

## CENTERPIECE (On Page 3)

Make plate doily. Around this put 6 tumbler doilies and between this make the stem and leaves as shown.

## Edgings

For simple luncheon sets, chair sets, bedroom sets, made of linen, an effective touch is added by using an edging, either simple or elaborate, and made of crochet cotton in either No. 50, 30, or 10, depending on the weight of the linen used. A medallion inserted in each of the corners makes a set unusual and one is amply repaid for the extra work.

\*R 8 ds, p, 3 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 3 ds, p, 8 ds. Do not close entirely, but leave 3-8 of an inch open between ends. Repeat from \* for desired length, always j by first p.

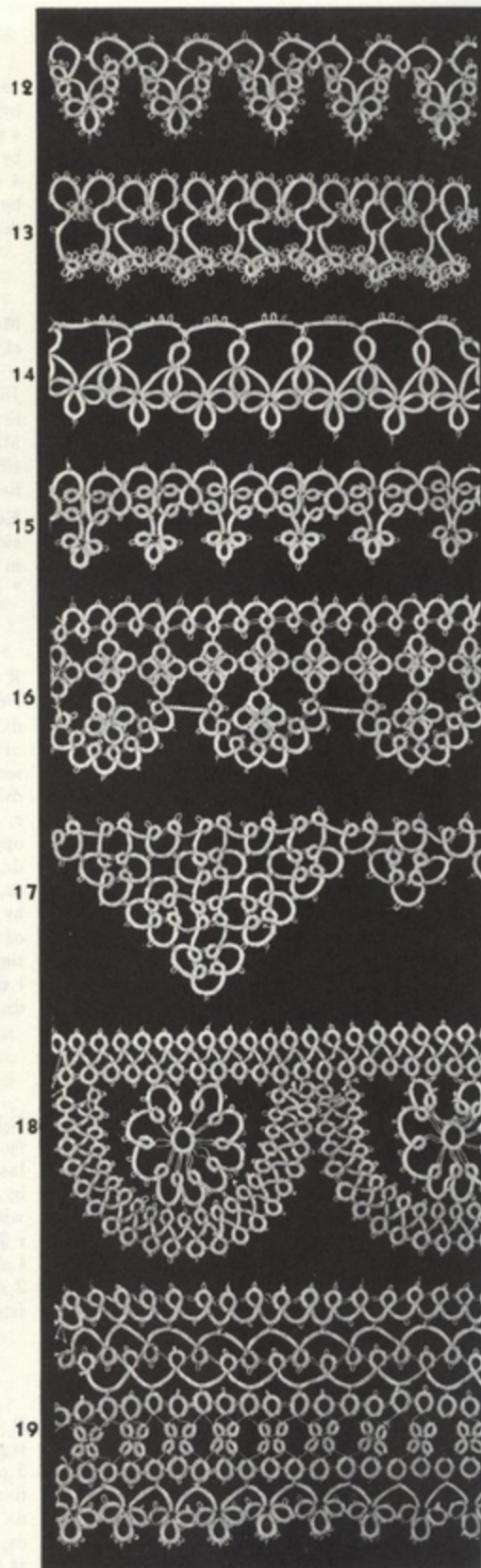

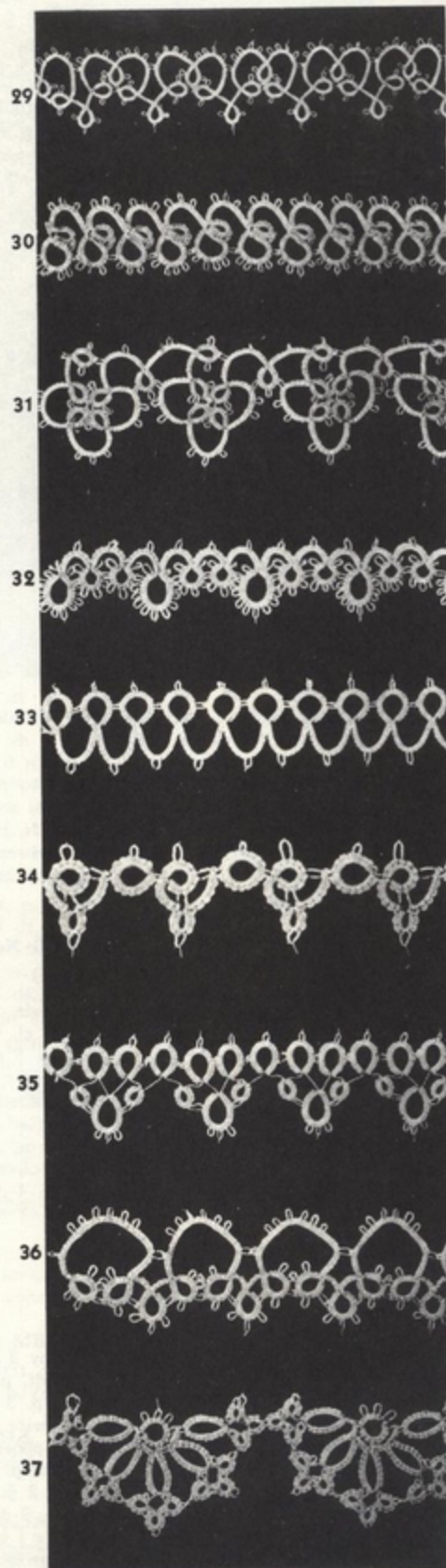

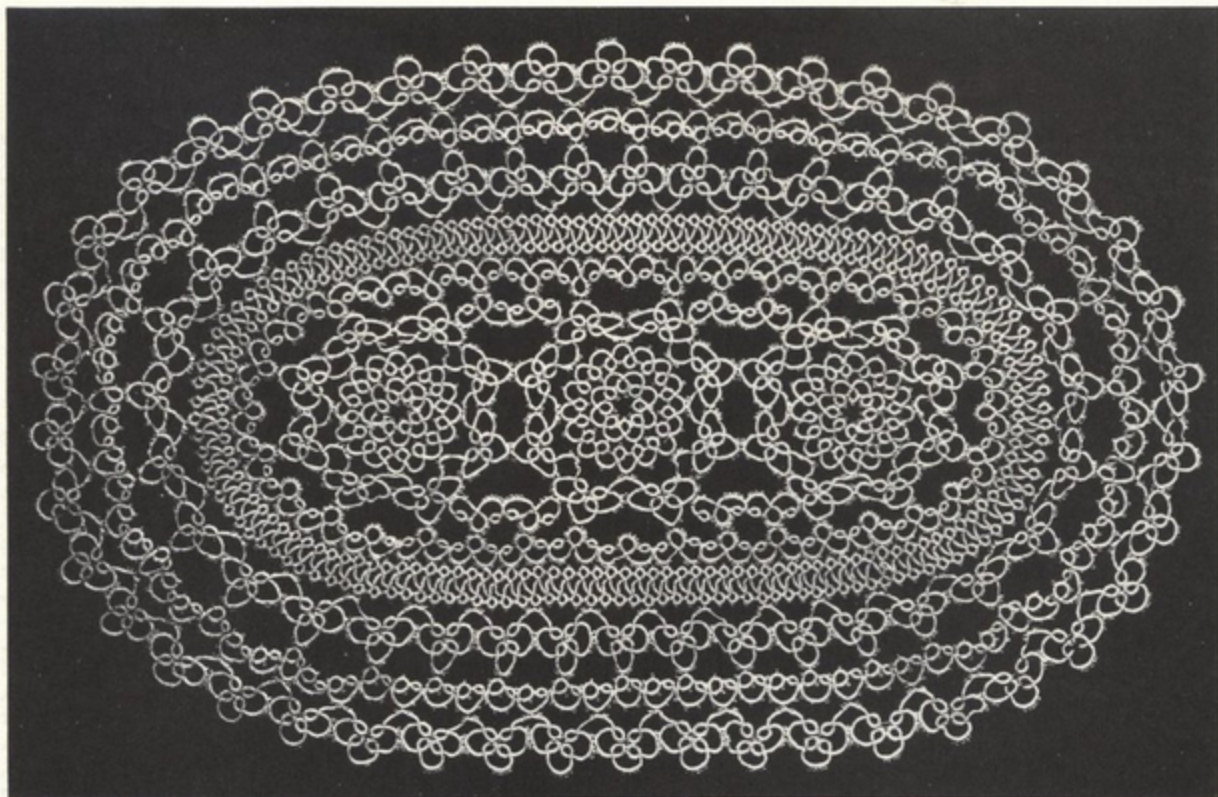

**8th row:** \* R 4 ds, 7 p sep by 2 ds, 4 ds, cl, turn, ch 4 ds, 2 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, j to center p of r (last row), 3 ds, 2 p sep by 3 ds, 4 ds, turn. Repeat from \* around. Tie and cut.

**9th row:** Join thread in center p of r of last row, \* ch 2 ds, 7 p, 2 ds, j in center p of next r of last row. Repeat from \* around. Tie and cut.

## MEDALLIONS FOR EDGE

**Center:** R 4 ds, 7 p, 4 ds, cl, (r 4 ds, j to seventh p of last r, 6 p, 4 ds, cl) 4 times, j the last r to first r. Tie and cut.

**Edge:** (R 4 ds, 7 p, 4 ds, cl) 3 times, \* turn, ch 5 ds, 2 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, j to center p of r (center), 2 ds, 2 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, turn, r 4 ds, 3 p, j to center p of last r, 3 p, 4 ds, cl, (r 4 ds, 7 p, 4 ds, cl) twice. Repeat from \* one more time, turn, (ch 5 ds, 2 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds. Join to center p of next center r, 2 ds, 2 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, turn, r 4 ds, 3 p, j to center p of last r, 3 p, 4 ds, cl, r 4 ds, 3 p, j to center p of ch (last row), 3 p, 4 ds, cl, r 4 ds, 7 p, 4 ds, cl) twice, ch 5 ds, 2 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, j to fourth p of next center r, 2 ds, 2 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, turn, r 4 ds, 3 p, j to center p of last r, 3 p, 4 ds, cl, r 4 ds, 7 p, 4 ds, cl, r 4 ds, 3 p, j to center p of first r, 3 p, 4 ds, cl, turn, ch 5 ds, 2 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, j to next p of same r with last ch, 2 ds, 2 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, j to first group of three r. Tie and cut.

## SMALL DOILY

**Center:** R 14 p sep by 2 ds, cl. Tie and cut. Make first and second rows of large doily. Then make medallions for edge as directed above.

**To Join Medallions:** Join center p of center r of shamrock to center p of r of last row. Skip 1 r of last row between each shamrock of the medallions.

## MEDIUM SIZE DOILY

To make a doily in medium size for a luncheon set, repeat the directions for the large round doily through the eighth row.

**2d row:** \*R 10 ds, p, 10 ds, cl, r 10 ds, j to center p of ch of last row, 10 ds, cl, r 10 ds, p, 10 ds, cl, (ch 3 ds, sr 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl) twice, ch 9 ds, p, 9 ds, (sr 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl, ch 3 ds) twice, r 10 ds, j to p of opposite r, 10 ds, cl, r 10 ds, j to first p of next ch, 10 ds, cl, r 10 ds, p, 10 ds, cl, (ch 3 ds, r 4 ds, j to p of opposite sr, 4 ds, cl) twice, ch 9 ds, p, 9 ds, (sr 4 ds, p, 4 ds, ch 3 ds) twice, r 10 ds, j to p of opposite r, 10 ds, cl, r 10 ds, j to third p of same ch, 10 ds, cl, 10 ds, p, 10 ds, cl, (ch 3 ds, r 4 ds, j to p of opposite sr, 4 ds, cl) twice, ch 9 ds, p, 9 ds, (sr 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl, ch 3 ds) twice. **2d row:** \*R 10 ds, j to center p of ch of last row, 10 ds, cl, ch 7 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 7 ds, r 10 ds, p, 10 ds, cl, ch 7 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 7 ds. Repeat from \* around. Tie and cut.

**3d row:** R 10 ds, lp, 10 ds, cl, (ch 7 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 7 ds, r 10 ds, j to lp of first r, 10 ds, cl) 3 times, \* ch 7 ds, 2 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, j to center p of ch of last row, 2 ds, 2 p sep by 2 ds, 7 ds, r 10 ds, lp, 10 ds, cl, ch 7 ds, p, 2 ds, j to fourth p of opposite ch, 2 ds, 3 p sep by 2 ds, 7 ds, (r 10 ds, j to lp of first r, 10 ds, cl, ch 7 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 7 ds) twice, r 10 ds, j to lp of first r, 10 ds, cl. Repeat from \* around. Tie and cut.

**4th row:** R 6 ds, j to center p of ch between 2 medallions, 6 ds, cl, turn, ch 9 ds, turn, (r 6 ds, j to p between the 2 clusters of 3 lr of medallion, 6 ds, cl, turn, ch 5 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, turn, r 6 ds, j to center p of center r of cluster, 6 ds, cl, turn, ch 5 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, turn) 8 times. r 6 ds, j between 2 clusters, 6 ds, cl, turn, ch 9 ds, turn, r 6 ds, j to center p of ch between 2 medallions, 6 ds, cl, turn, ch 9 ds, turn, r 6 ds, j to p between the 2 clusters of 3 lr of next medallion, 6 ds, cl, turn, ch 5 ds, 2 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, j to center p of opposite ch, 2 ds, 2 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds. Repeat around each medallion. Tie and cut.

**5th row:** \* R 6 ds, j to center p of ch (to left) between 2 scallops, 3 ds, j to center p of opposite ch (to right), 6 ds, cl, turn, ch 8 ds, turn, (r 6 ds, j to center p of next ch, 6 ds, cl, turn, ch 5 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, turn)

twice, (r 6 ds, j to second p of next ch, 6 ds, cl, turn, ch 5 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, turn, r 6 ds, j to fourth p of same ch, 6 ds, cl, turn, ch 5 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, turn, r 6 ds, j to center p of next ch, 6 ds, cl, turn, ch 5 ds, 5 p sep by 2 ds, 5 ds, turn) 5 times, ch 8 ds, turn. Repeat from \* around. Tie and cut.

**6th row:** Make like fifth row, j r to center p of each ch of last row. Tie and cut.

**8th row:** Make like first row, sk the 2 ch at base of scallop, j the sr to third and fifth p of ch of last row.

**9th row:** \* R 6 ds, j to center p of lr between 2 scallops, 6 ds, cl, (turn, ch 4 ds, 7 p sep by 2 ds, 4 ds, turn, r 6 ds, j to center p of next center r of cluster, 6 ds, cl, turn, ch 4 ds, 7 p sep by 2 ds, 4 ds, turn, r 6 ds, j to p between 2 clusters, 6 ds, cl) 10 times, (turn, ch 4 ds, 7 p sep by 2 ds, 4 ds, turn, r 6 ds, j to center p of lr, 6 ds, cl) 3 times, turn, ch 4 ds, 7 p sep by 2 ds, 4 ds, turn. Repeat from \* around. Tie and cut.

### FOR MEDIUM-SIZE DOILY

Make center as for large doily and omit sixth and seventh rows of large doily, and add eighth and ninth rows.

### FOR SMALL DOILY

Make 6 medallions as in large doily. Join 5 around 1 medallion by center p of 2 center r of clusters. Then make a row around the medallions like outer row of large doily.

**9th row:** \* R 5 ds, j to third p of a r, 5 ds, p, 5 ds, j to first p of next r, 5 ds, cl, ch 2 ds, 9 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, repeat from \* around. Tie and cut.

**10th row:** Tie the 2 shuttle threads together, lr 1 ds, p, 3 ds, j to center p of scallop, 3 ds, 2 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, r st 2 ds, p, 3 ds, (sep r 2 ds, p, 2 ds, cl) 3 times, sp  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch (sr, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, cl) 3 times, (3 ds, 2 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds) on unfinished r, cl, \* tie both threads together close to lr, shuttle No. 1, (sr 2 ds, p 2 ds) 3 times, with shuttle No. 2 make 3 sr like cluster just made. Tie both threads together close to last sr, lr 3 ds, 5 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, r st 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. Tie threads close to lr. Make another group of 3 sr like others, lr 3 ds, 2 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, sk 1 scallop, j to center p of next scallop, 3 ds, 2 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, r st 3 ds, 2 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, cl, repeat from \* around ending with lr (3 ds, p, 3 ds, j in center of sp of first group of sr, 3 ds, 2 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, r st 3 ds, 2 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, cl. Tie and cut.

**11th row:** \* R 5 ds, 3 p sep by 5 ds, 5 ds, cl, ch 2 ds, 4 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, j to center p of lr, 2 ds, 4 p sep

by 2 ds, 2 ds, (r 5 ds, 3 p sep by 5 ds, 5 ds, cl, ch 2 ds, 9 p sep by 2 ds, 2 ds) twice, repeat from \* around. Tie and cut.

Make 15 medallions using the first 4 rows of the doily. Join the medallions together by center p of 3 scallops, (for first 2 medallions), sk 8 scallops, j third medallion to center p of next 3 scallops, j all together making a circle.

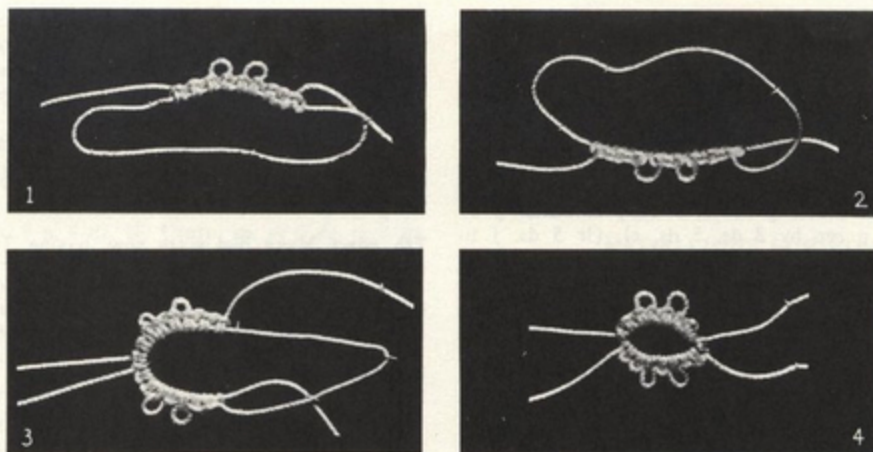

## Helpful Suggestions



### DIRECTIONS FOR THE REVERSE STITCH

Begin ring, making three double stitches, picot, two double stitches, picot, three double stitches (figure one) (this is one-half of ring), take work off from hand\* (reverse), turn over (figure two), put work on hand so that the thread which was under is now over the hand. Take shuttle No. 2 and make the other half of the ring, with the reverse stitch, which is done by holding the thread on the hand taut, and making the stitch with the thread from the shuttle, making three double stitches, picot, two double stitches, picot, three double stitches (figure three), take work from hand, turn over\*, take shuttle No. 1 and close ring (figure four).

In joining while doing reverse work, do not draw shuttle very taut after passing through joining loop, but draw the loop back again so that the joining stitch is made with the thread from shuttle and the thread on the hand may be drawn back and forth.

### AN OLD ART REVIVED

Let's all start tatting together! When one sees the effective new designs shown here and the lovely thread on the market, the discriminating needleworker will be intrigued by the possibilities of the combination, which are endless, and will not rest until the work takes form under her hands and is completed.

There will be found lovely colors as well as white in both crochet and tatting cotton and there also comes another type that is called "shaded," the colors being pink, blue, yellow, lavender, green, and black and white, in toning of the same color, which makes ideal trimmings for dainty handkerchiefs. There is also made a range of tinted colors in this tatting cotton—that is, combinations of different colors with white that are well balanced both in hue and tone. One will love the articles that are made with them.

However, after seeing the specialized materials available today, one will wonder how needleworkers of olden times made such beautiful lasting articles from the threads then obtainable. The thread used was coarser, rougher, and with no regularity of spinning, for tatting is an old lace-making art and has come down to us from the Middle Ages, when it apparently developed in several parts of the world.

The Italians gave it a name meaning "eye," because of the similarity of the rings to the eyes; the French gave it a name to describe its delicate appearance; the Orientals call it by a word meaning "the shuttle," which is used in making; and in America, it is called "tatting," probably from the word "tatters," as it is made in sections which are then connected.

Designs in the early days, before the printing press was invented, were handed from neighbor to neighbor and copied in this way; but today, the large modern illustrations and clear directions make the work very easy. It is suggested that the directions, abbreviations, and notes be carefully read before starting work.

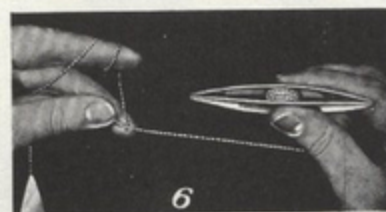
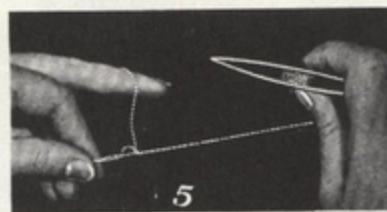
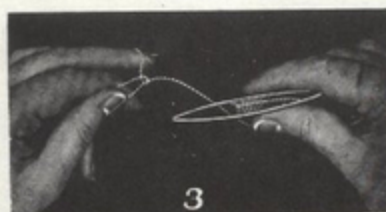
There is included in this book the most useful up-to-date articles for this work, from tiny edgings of the finest thread for handkerchiefs, dainty baby caps, a lacy yoke for silk underwear, to medallions and edgings with which to decorate linens; also doilies of several sizes, and a chair set for medium-size threads. Many of these lovely articles may be made of different size thread, depending on the space in which they are to be used. As coarse a thread as size No. 10 is practical if desired.

There is really no limit to the possibilities of tatting, for this needle-art is composed of knots and stitches, made lacy with loops of picots, for the different arrangements produce many and varied patterns, as shown in the preceding pages.

Tatting is a form of lace made with a tatting shuttle, and for some designs only one shuttle is needed, while for others two are required. In the latter case, it is more convenient to have a second shuttle.



# Instructions for Tatting



As will be judged, the simplest form of tatting is the ring which is made with one shuttle, and when a chain is introduced, the second shuttle is required. In learning to tat, the knot is made on the shuttle thread, and not with it though all the action is taken with the shuttle thread, shown in illustration No. 3. A second important fact to remember is that the shuttle thread is pulled taut before the knot is tightened.

First, wind the thread around the bobbin in the shuttle, layer over layer, but the thread should never extend over the edge.

To make a ring: Hold the shuttle between the thumb and forefinger of the right hand as shown. Hold the end of the thread between the thumb and forefinger of the left hand and pass it around the fingers of this hand, not too tightly, crossing it under the thumb. It is with this loop of thread that the ring is worked and this is called the ring thread. Throw the shuttle thread over the right hand as in illustration No. 1. Pass the shuttle between the first and second fingers of left hand under the shuttle and ring threads and back over ring thread, allowing the ring thread to fall slack by bringing the four fingers of the left hand together. Pull shuttle thread taut, then open the fingers of the left hand until the loop is caught with the thumb, as shown in No. 3.

For the second half, the thread is dropped instead of raised, shuttle is passed over the left-hand thread instead of under (as before), is brought through below, between the two threads (as before) and drawn up in the same way. (Illustration No. 2.) Illustration No. 4 shows the second half of stitch slipping into place beside the first half.

This group is called a double stitch and is the main stitch used in tatting. In making this, it will be found that by pulling the shuttle thread and then the ring thread, the stitch slips back and forth on the shuttle thread. If it does not, the stitch has been locked and must be made over again.

Illustration No. 5 shows a picot which is made by leaving a space of thread between the stitches, and to join two picots, draw the working thread through the picot and pass shuttle through loop. Then draw up close to resemble a half stitch, but not to be counted as one.

Two shuttles are required to make a design having a chain. Tie the threads together and hold between the thumb and second finger of the left hand and with the first finger outstretched, wind the thread around it two or three times, allowing the second shuttle to drop as on No. 6. The stitches for the chain are made with the thread between the first and second fingers in the same way as those for the rings.

## NOTES

All beginners should use coarse thread to see work better. Never break off thread after winding shuttle if directions call for chain (ch). When a shuttle has a point or hook, be careful to keep point forward. Rings are to be made close together unless directions call for space (sp). A ring is always to be drawn close unless otherwise stated. Space

means to allow thread between last ring and new one. When making medallions, doilies, or centerpieces, the work will be lovelier and easier to do if it is pressed every two or three rows, in the desired form, and to do this place on a thick pad, shape, and press over a damp cloth, and then a dry one, until the piece is dry. This will show how the work is going, and will keep it from being too full or too tight.
